



CODE OF CONDUCT

Mobile Phones 📵

No Delegate, member of the Media, IP, Crisis staff or Logistics team is allowed to carry a mobile phone. Any mobile phone brought will be confiscated and will not be returned for three months.

Internet and Other Electronic Devices 🌐

Senior Delegates and IP members are allowed to carry laptops only; iPads, tablets. Internet dongles are not allowed. Internet access, if any, will be provided only at the discretion of the Bureau.

Junior Delegates (Class 5th and 6th) are not permitted to carry laptops on any of the three conference days and will not have internet access. They must bring printed hard copies of all required reference material from home.

Water Bottles 🍷

All students attending the Shishukunj MUN are required to bring their own water bottle to school on the conference days, labelled with the child's name in permanent marker. Please note that to take a step towards sustainable living, no packaged water bottles will be provided. There will be water dispensers located outside of each committee room which can be used by everyone to refill their water bottles.

No liquids other than water — including soft drinks, soda, or shakes — are permitted in the water bottles.

Transportation 🚌

Buses will ply on all routes during the conference days for both arrival and departure. No participants will be allowed to leave the conference in between. Once they arrive, they will only be allowed to depart after the completion of that day's sessions. Students must board the same bus they arrived on for departure — **no request for change of bus will be permitted**, under any circumstances.



Photography and Video

Throughout the conference, Shishukunj MUN staff, Media Team and representatives may take photographs, videos and interviews that show the conference participants which may be used for promotional, educational or other purposes for Shishukunj MUN. By attending the conference, participants give consent to be photographed, videotaped, and/or interviewed and authorize Shishukunj MUN to use them in any manner of Shishukunj MUN's choosing.



Dress Code and Conference IDs

To maintain and enhance security, all participants of the Shishukunj MUN are required to visibly wear the conference IDs which will be given to them upon their arrival. Everyone has to comply with the dress code at all times during the conference. If anyone's attire is deemed inappropriate by the Secretariat or the school administration, the student will be asked to leave the session and return with appropriate attire.



Misplaced Items

The school shall not be held accountable for any items **lost or misplaced** by students during the conference days. Delegates are advised to keep their belongings, especially valuables, with them at all times.



Expulsion from the Conference

The Secretariat, with consultation to the MUN coordinator reserves the right to expel any Delegate, IP, Media and Logistics member from the conference at any time for violating or failing to comply with conference regulations, or any other disciplinary infraction. Expulsions shall take effect immediately at the time that they are issued. All conference registration materials (i.e. conference IDs and placards) must be surrendered to the conference staff upon expulsion.



Attendance

The participants will be awarded the certificate of participation and be considered for awards only after attending a minimum of 13 hours of committee sessions.
